ARTICLE IV Meetings

SECTION 7: SECTION 7: Each Teocalli of the Association must receive permission from the CSQA Board of Directors to conduct an Artisan Degree. This is to ensure that multiple events or degrees do not conflict with others in the Association. This will also ensure that the Degree/Event does not occur within 60 (Sixty) days of an Association Degree/Event. The CSQA Board will not approve any Artisan Degree event that is not a multi-day event or allows one-day registrations, all Artisan Degrees will be full-feathered from memory. A minimum of two (2) CSQA Board members must be in attendance to consecrate the Artisans.

SECTION 7: SECTION 7: Each Teocalli of the Association must receive permission from the CSQA Board of Directors to conduct an Artisan Degree. This will also ensure that the Degree/Event does not occur within ~~60 (Sixty)~~ 45 (Forty-five) days of an Association Degree/Event. The CSQA Board will not approve any Artisan Degree event that is not a multi-day event or allows one-day registrations, all Artisan Degrees will be full-feathered from memory. A minimum of two (2) CSQA Board members must be in attendance to consecrate the Artisans.
